The company has performed in the UK, Europe, North America, Australia and New Zealand.</p> <p>They have created over 25 Productions, ranging from the large scale Get Lost! dotMaze show, to solo shows, smaller installations and walkabout pieces. They specialize in site-specific commissions, including pieces for The Manchester Commonwealth Games, The Brit Awards and the 2011 Rugby World Cup in New Zealand.</p> <p>They also offer workshops in Street Art, recently working with students from Winchester University and The Mint Fest Lakes Alive.
